**Governor's Survey.**—We understand it is intended to have a regular thorough government survey of the whole of Utah, topographical and geological, at an early day. It will tend greatly to enhance the material interests, especially the mineral resources of the Territory.

**Already the exploration services of Hayden, Wheeler, Powell and King have resulted in giving a large amount of reliable information in relation to Utah and the surrounding territory, but the peculiarities of the more central portion of the Territory require a thorough and complete investigation.**

**There are maps of southern and some portions of central Utah, illustrating the geology and topography of the territory, and the knowledge of the Northern Utah and who is also being gradually accumulated, and South-eastern Utah will probably soon be reported and fully described.**

**We cannot know too much of the natural resources of the country in which we live, and especially of their application in directions productive of commerce and commercial enterprise.**

**Manti Fossils.**—The beautiful white lime rock, found at Mant, which is being used for building the Temple in this city, is becoming very interesting to scientists, by reason of the fossils contained in some specimens quarried there.

**During the recent visit of Professor Hayden to this city, a slab, containing a well-preserved Ganoidea, was seen by that gentleman and other scientists at the Museum, which was deemed of sufficient importance to be borrowed and sent to the Smithsonian Institution, to be identified and returned.**

**A cast of a Ganoidea has been sent up by Brother Hayden, of Mant, which is likely to attract much attention. In this fossil the bones have mostly been broken off, but sufficient remain to identify it as being the remains of a variety of emys, many of which are described by Dr. Leidy, in his reliable report of the Vertebrates. The specimen was yesterday deposited at the Museum by the courtesy of Patriarch John Smith.**

**Specimens of the Indian relic, in hard yellow, with ornamental seeds, etc., have been presented by Hon. A. C. Thurber. The latter were alluded to in the News recently.**
