The official count of the county gives the Democrats 2,940 majority. The county is claimed by the Republicans by 300 and Thomas county by 150 majority. North Georgia has gone Democratic. It is impossible to give anything more satisfactory to-night, but there appears to be no doubt that the Democrats have carried the State by 30,000 majority, as a full vote has been polled in every county.

The Morning News will publish returns from thirty-five counties, all of which, except two, are decidedly Democratic. The following counties, which now give 8,000 majority for Smith, gave the gubernatorial election in '68 a combined majority of 9,914 for Bullock, Hancock, Monroe, Baldwin, Warren, Clayton, Mitchell, Morgan, Murray, and Troup. The returns from all parts of the State show large gains over '68. Smith is elected by nearly 50,000 majority. The election is one of the most quiet and peaceful ever held in Georgia.

WASHINGTON.—In the course of conversation yesterday with a gentleman, the President referred to the coming universal exposition at Vienna, next May, and he hoped there a good representation of American art and industry would be found in competition with the products of Europe. He said that if no government aid should be granted to the exhibitors, as in other countries. He also declared his intention of asking, in his forthcoming message to Congress, for a sufficient appropriation to send a delegation of American workmen to Vienna, under the direction of a United States commissioner, for the purpose of reporting upon the progress of industrial arts in Europe, as revealed by the exposition.

WILMINGTON, Del.—The complete returns from all parts of the State of the elections yesterday, for assessor and other local officers, give a Democratic majority of 32, which was the Republican gain of the vote two years ago for similar offices.

ST. LOUIS.—Father Burke lectured this evening to the Little Sisters of the poor. His escort consisted of nearly 100 of the Irish Societies, with the city bands and torches.

TURNER, minister to Liberia, was formally received at the Temple, which was crowded with a large audience.

ATLANTA, Ga.—The returns from twenty counties give Smith, the Democratic nominee for governor, 10,000 majority. If the same proportion holds in the counties to be heard from, Smith's majority will be over 40,000.

RALEIGH.—An inquest was held today on the body of the Rev. J. Brinson Smith, who died suddenly yesterday. A verdict was rendered. The stomach of the deceased was found to contain a quantity of arsenic. It is thought that the cause of death was poisoning by a sedition powder, which he drank, but how the poison came in has not been ascertained.

ATLANTA, Ga.—A riot occurred at the polls this morning between the whites and blacks. It commenced with fistful fights, which developed into fierce encounters with bricks and stones. In the course of the riot, about thirty persons were killed and five or six negroes wounded, two of whom have since died. The riot broke out at a few minutes past noon, when the negroes left the polls. The whites claim that the whole affair was premeditated on the part of the negroes; that it was their intention to take forcible possession of the polls, and that they originated the disturbance for this object. The negroes, however, claim that they were driven from the polls by violence, and could get no chance to vote. They were addressed by the Mayor later in the day, who guaranteed them protection, but with few exceptions they refused to vote.
