EGAN SAYS SO.

Salt Lake for Short Line
Headquarters.

THAT IS STRAIGHT TALK.

Bound To Portland Never Contem-
plated at All

THE HEARING TOMORROW.

Novel of How John H. Thompson
and Other Prominent
Baltimoreans.

The News was right. Mr. Egan is truly towards Utah in general and Salt Lake in particular. He has said a word in language that will stick in the memory of all who have been present at the hearing. The trial of this city and Territory may not be assessed on that point, but it will not be forgotten by any one who has ever been present at the Oregon Short Line, following the appointment of Frank Trumbull to the Denver & Gulf and Colorado Central divisions of that great system, a year and a half ago, presaging a general dissolution of one of the greatest railroad systems of this country. It is said at Union Pacific headquarters in Omaha that the conditions imposed by Judge Smith were not so much against the Union Trust company, but this is distinctly denied by representatives of that concern, who declare that Mr. Egan will make reparation and insist him to set the money that is needed to complete the Denver & Gulf and the Great Northern. The interest of the mortgage bondholders, and E. P. Thompson of St. Paul, who represents the divided interests on the several mortgages, were also mentioned.

Mr. Egan arrived here from the coast this morning and will direct to Salt Lake, where he will stay until his necessarily quietness has been definitely passed upon by Judge McNeely.

The absorbing question of the division was, of course, the social issue—the satisfactory settling of which means so much to the past of this Territory.

A representative of the News sought interview with Mr. Egan and was cordially and pleasantly received by the gentleman. It was the first time he had the pleasure of meeting him and if the old saying is true that the first impression is the lasting one, it is clear that he has made a good impression.

The program of the hearing was as follows: Mr. Egan presented his personal and above all his own "mind of his own," strength and independence of character, emphasized in every feature of his life, and his record of service. In railway matters he has had a lifetime experience, and is known and well known and in sympathy throughout, while the rapid development of the great west.

The first point to be taken up was that of polarization, or the question of the separate trusteeship, and it is a very decided policy in case he should be confirmed by the court to be necessarily silent. However, as to legal procedure, he said he would not be bound by the rules of the Senate.

The second point to be taken up was the matter of the railroads.

"When the matter first coming in Salt Lake was not settled, it carried the weight of the entire country. I know it to be a sensible, promising business city. There are many divisions of labor, and the railroads, of course, was basic. As far as I could see, the suggestion that I would be retained, but that is another matter concerning it. It would be impossible to do anything at this time, but I do not know what to do with anything against Salt Lake. On the contrary I know it to be a sensible, promising business city. The care of the news of the system is and will be here. The thought of removing the railroads from the state did not enter my mind at all at any time. That kind of work was simply all over.

"I mind you, (with marked emphasis on the "you") I come here and have nothing to do with that. I want to see the people most present along the greater part of the greater West's business. The interests of the railroads are not mine. They are not mine. You can say 'yes' and Mr. Egan is closing. "But the head of the short line will not be removed from Salt Lake." Then he stopped from further questioning the part of the newspaperman and interview terminated.

The atmosphere around the Union Pacific long offices is of an indignation. The feelings seem to be generally entertained by the employes that Egan's appointment will be confirmed.
