Purchase of Silver on Account of the Indian Government.

BUSINESS MEN DISCUSS MATTERS.

In Favor of Free Coinage.—Congressman Hanger Discusses a Remedy.

WASHINGTON, July 6.—General A. J. Warner, president of the American Bimetallic league, said today that he may look for purchases of silver on account of the Indian government any time. In fact, that government has accepted a bill of law, except that it fixed the ratio at 20 for converting rupees into silver. If the ratio of the West remains closed for any length of time silver will rise as a result of purchases by our government on an account of India.
