EUROPE AND CRETE.

Russia Charges England With a Policy of Vexatious.

GERMANY'S POSITION DEFINED.

Not Easy to Get a Governor—Mokhammad Attended Aid by Christian Ministers.

New York, April 4.—A dispatch to the Herald from St. Petersburg says:

It seems to look very much as if England and Russia were understanding the position of Crete, as they at the moment are the only two powers actively disposed.

The St. Petersburg Herald today says:

"As matters appear we merely wait the day when the telegraph will bring us the news that England, with one of the other powers, has secured a candidate to occupy Crete."

It is understood that England has intimated her willingness, in the case of need, to cooperate with another power, at the same time feeling it to be known that the task is distasteful enough and undertaken only in case of absolute need, to prevent disaster.

The position of Germany, which has been much criticized as being the power that largest strong arm and now fails to set up her part, needed definition. It is absolutely given as that.

German participation in the strongest position terms the immediate blockade of Greece as the solution in the case of need, but that was six weeks ago. Then neither the Greek nor the Turkish army had been mobilized, and the position of the king of Greece would have been saved, and the fact of German participation stopped. For lack of compromise in action, England, France and Italy have been deemed to have encouraged the Greeks and Crete in their lawlessness and brought about the deplorable and deplorable position.

That is the reason why Germany refuses to take part in sending troops, and to assist her in the case of the weakness of others. In Russia, England is held to have been the greatest offender in her action, and also, causing a well known prejudice here to remark.

"English makes proposition which we accept, and before our reply has time to reach London she has changed her mind and launched some other action, cancelling the first. For instance, it was Lord Salisbury's cabinet which suggested the blockade of Yola. Now they don't want it, and it is easy to explain the irritation which exists here, at the present state of affairs for which Russia is to be responsible, but into which she is unwilling, yet inevitably drawn."

Meanwhile, the utmost efforts are being made to procure an able governor for Crete. Belgium has been approached, but although she has many competent men, none can take the life and reputation among the evil-minded Greek islanders whose insurrection is the cause of the trouble, in which even priests have taken part, to the village of Zante, she has been in memory.

The definite appointment of Admiral Canaris in the direction of affairs, after the submission of the government, is approved here but apparently objected to by the French.

CHRISTIAN MINISTERS.
