6th. Wagons should not be loaded above the following weights:

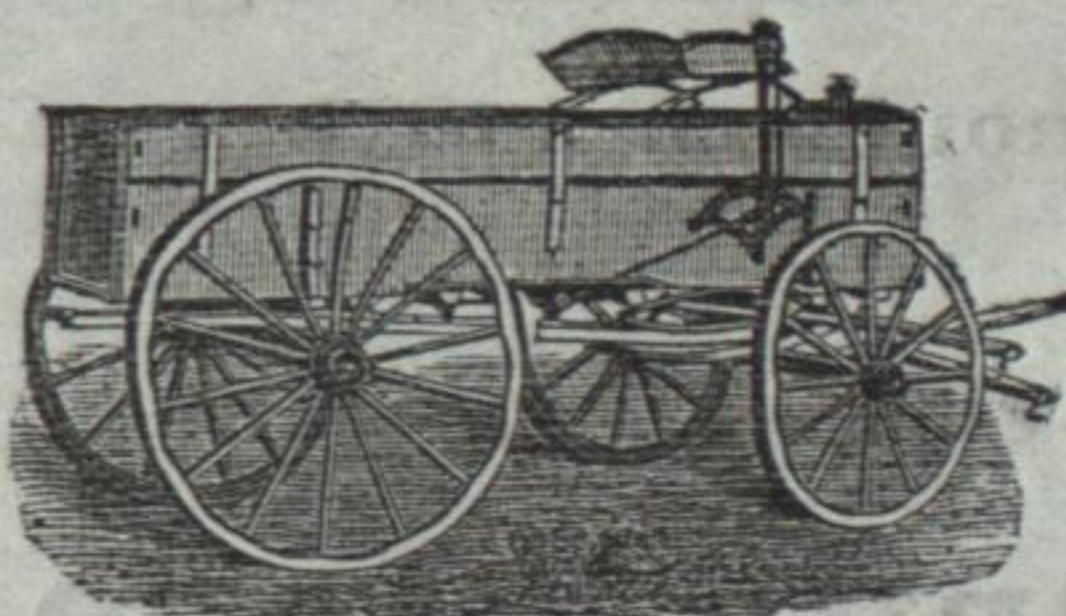
