

THE MINING BILL.

B DEFEATS ALL OPPOSITION, AND PASSES.

THE FIRE AND POLICE BILL.

EXECUTIVE SCENE OF THE COUNCIL—BUSINESS TRANSMITTED TODAY.

Hatch's bill to regulate the locating and recording of mining claims, is a measure which makes some radical changes in the existing order of things in reference to those subjects. It requires mining records to be deposited with the county recorder, who has the power to appoint deputies in the mining districts, requires a certain amount of work to be done within forty days from the date of location, and contains other provisions that are new in the present laws relating to this subject. The bill, with determined opposition in the Senate, and on the floor of the House, was passed, but it passed the House by a vote of 12 to 6, and is to undergo its experiments.

Powers' bill creating a board of fire and police commissioners, has been pending a long time in the house of a Council committee, it has been the subject of a good deal of thought, and has not with a great deal of opposition, but no action has followed my suggestion, and has not entirely defeated it. The Senate, however, has passed it, and it is now in the Council, with amendments. It is thought the House will enact it into law, and that the measure will be adopted without opposition. The bill creates a board of five, to consist of the chief of police, the fire chief, and two others appointed by the city council. The bill is to prevent trade marks, and is to be enacted at the earliest possible moment.
