COMMISSIONER MORGAN'S LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE CATHOLIC MISSION BOARD.

Washington, July 19.—The Commissioner of Education, Mr. William H. Morgan, has just received from the President of the Catholic Mission Board, Mr. John J. Ryan, a letter in which Mr. Ryan expresses his views on the propriety of appropriating public funds to sectarian institutions.

Mr. Morgan's reply to Mr. Ryan's letter is published in full in this issue.

Mr. Morgan states that he is in favor of the government system of schools, and that he believes that the public funds should be used for non-sectarian purposes.

Mr. Morgan also states that he believes that the public funds should be used for the benefit of all children, regardless of their religious faith.

Mr. Morgan concludes his letter by stating that he believes that the government system of schools is the best system for the education of the people.
