SALT LAKE CITY, Oct. 1.—The Priester murder case is as much of a mystery as ever so far as the public is concerned.

Jackson, the suspected man who was apprehended at Ogden, refused to return as a witness, and the warrant issued for his arrest was not served.

He concealed himself this morning by going away, and gave the officers testimony which they refuse to divulge, but which they say will lead to the arrest of the guilty parties within twenty-four hours.
