Tortures of Mexican Penitents.

SAGUACHE, Col., April 16, 1876.

Exciting mining news from this

San Juan El Dorado has been com-

pletely overthrown and is now

the most terrible and disgusting

performances of the "Penitentes."

In Saguache County there

exists a numerous Mexican popu-

lation, and during the last three days

of Lent in Holy Week, their penan-

ces culminated in the most atro-

cious and revolting manner in

which they ever performed.

Penitentes from the neighbor-

hood to other Mexican villages

at a distance, and these from other

plazas come here to perform their

acts. These make their appearance

usually in the night, heavily

clothed in black, and with their

faces and hands painted white.

The members of the com-

munity wherever they appear

themselves never leave a case from

whence to draw their robes, or

without a word.

These Penitentes are supposed to

be people who have committed

some serious sin, and are sent

to the place of penance, and are

punished by the priests, and are

sentenced to certain acts of

self-torture.

Early in the week here it

was reported in town that a man

was to be crucified on the Friday

following. To the south of Saguache,

about fifteen miles, there is a

small settlement of Mexican

settlers. It is also close to the foot

of the mountain range, and its in-

habitants are engaged in stock

raising and agriculture. A
