The Sons of the Golden West Hold a Celebration at the Fair.

### STATE BUILDING DEDICATED.

A Bazaar Display Exciting the Admiration of All—Unique Souvenir.

CHICAGO, June 18.—The Native Sons of the Golden West were at the World's Fair today in large numbers. They wore gold badges, shaped like a sturdy boat, labeled "Gold Country," and the "paddle," and had a jolly good time, and made their guests have a jolly good time, too. The celebration of their gathering was the formal dedication of the California state building, and they celebrated the event with that free, gay grace for which Californians are famous. The big building was lavishly decorated outside and inside with flags, flowers and plants, caravans, boats, from the full of the golden state, and from every corner of the nation, adding to the general pleasure of the day.

NEW YORK STOCKS.

NEW YORK, June 19.—Stocks were extremely active after the opening of the California World's Fair examination spoke of the work done by California towards making the great exposition a success. Several soils that used to sound the verandas before the fortyness flooded into the gold fields are being used in the quaint tower which stands in the center of the building, and other sun-touched stones surround it, and it is filled with various products of the state said to have the finest climate in the world. The building has a total floor space of 12,000 feet, and cost nearly \$100,000, while the exhibits will not reach the value of the exhibits.

A USEFUL INVENTION.

Raising Water for Irrigating Purposes in the Flat River.

DOUGLAS, Wyo., June 18.—Thousands of acres of fertile agricultural land along the Platte river in this state now lie idle because of the expense of irrigating the same. F. H. Harvey and Albert Cough have just invented a plant for raising the water which will reduce the cost of irrigation to less than one-half cent per acre.

The invention consists of a pump and

engine, which will raise the water

from the bottom of the river to the top of the hill.

The invention is simple, and can be easily constructed.

MORE FAILURES.

A Bank with More Assets Than Liabilities.

WASHINGTON, June 18.—The Bank of New Haven has failed. The assets are \$1 million and a quarter and the liabilities eight hundred thousand.

A notice on the door of the bank says, "Due to the want of capital and the withdrawal of \$100,000 more and because of inability to realize quickly on the assets, the bank has decided to resign." The depositors will be paid in full. The balance will be given to the New Haven savings and trust company.

The New Haven bank has been engaged in increasing the financial strength of the army by systematically reducing the pay of soldiers, and reducing the period of service to 18 years.
