Bittor Descret News: Bluff City is situated on the Ban Juan River, fifteen miles of the Arizona line, and forty miles east of the Colorado line. Two hundred and thirty eight miles south of Salt Lake City, and one hundred and thirty-two cas:, at an altinde of 4,649 feet above sea level. Eighteen miles up the river, and nearly due east, is the settlement of Montezu-ma, while eighty miles forther up the river and in the edge of New Mexico is the settlement of Bum-ham. These three settlements, with a few scattered families along the river and on the Mancos form the river and on the Mancos form the Ban Juan Stake, presided over by Platte D. Lyman.

At Montezuma there are only At Montezums there are only seven families, located at intervals over a distance of seven miles. They have some good land, and much that is not so good. Their supply of water is obtaided by means of water wheels, hoisting the wpter from the San Juan River.

At Bluff City there are about 35 families, principally from Iron and Garfield counties, Utah, who located here about four years ago. Possibly double that number of people have, at times, resided here, but for various reasons have moved to different localties. The climate here is warm and

The climate here is warm and pleasant, in fact almost everything that could be desired in that direction corn, melons, tomatoes and all classes of cereals, maturing to a good advantage, with the exception of Irish potatoes, which do not seem to do the best, sweet potatoes woul; doubtless grow finely. The nearest saw timber is in the Blue Mountains 40 miles distant; fire wood and house logs of cottonwcod, can be obtained along the river; a fine article of sandatone is easily obtainable, and in great quantities.
