Sister L. D. Allard made an earnest appeal to encourage and foster the Kindergarten schools now established in Salt Lake City. She reported that the board of directors of these schools had an indebtedness of about \$800 to their bands for teachers' salaries and equipments for the instruction of the children. Every effort had been put forth to keep these schools going, but the Latter-day Saints had not given the support needed by sending their children and paying the small fee of 25 cents per week. The school had well trained and efficient teachers to instruct the children. But the institution was gradually failing for lack of means. It had now come to a point where all must be had or the school be closed indefinitely.

Elder Angus M. Cannon, Charles W. Penrose, Elias Morris, Joseph E. Taylor and John W. Taylor delivered some very spirited remarks on the question of organizing the Kindergarten association, which resulted in the following resolution being unanimously adopted by the conference:

That the independence of this institution for the training of the children of all the Latter-day Saints in the city of Salt Lake City, and the encouragement of the parents who are in Salt Lake City, in making their children attend the schools, will be most beneficial to the welfare of the children. And that the Kindergarten association, for the time being, be organized under the name of the "Kindergarten Association of the Stake," to secure the services of the Stake to help in the work.

Elder Angus M. Cannon—One great trouble with this Stake of Zion was the annual stake conference. At the end of each year there was a better attendance of the Stake than there was in the Stake meeting of the people here. Children were being taught in the assemblies, and hence the necessity of giving them religious instruction is given them at home if they cannot be sent to school even with their brethren and sisters.

The priest should set an example to the people and the father should set an example to his children. It is easier and garnishes a proper example the parents and children would follow, rather than the fathers and mothers. The Stake should leave it to the parents to decide what should be done with the children in danger. The heads of families should be visited and seen what their children are and if they are attending their meetings, if the brothers will not tell the parents to let them go. If the parents do not want to keep the course given him, he should not stay there. It is not right to keep him in his position, but the parents should be told to let him go with who will. He closed with an exhortation to self-sacrifice for the cause of Zion.


