LOCAL BRIEFS.

Election in Signal Corps—The signal corps of the National Guard of Utah will hold an election for two first lieutenants at the armory next Thursday evening.

High School for Benjamin—Prof. C. C. Maynard of Benjamin, visiting in the city, says Benjamin is to have a high school building this next year.

Cadets in Competition—The annual drill for the competition gold medal at All Hallows college will be held Friday next at 2 p. m. Capt. Barrett of the National Guard will inspect the battalion.

Henry Percy Dead—Henry Percy, a consumptive, aged 53, was found dead in bed at 1 o'clock this morning in the Midland rooming house. He leaves a wife in England and several children in this country.

Faculty as Hosts—There was a large attendance at last night's students' dance at the state university gymnasium. The faculty acted as hosts for the evening. The decorations were in national colors. The function was much enjoyed.

Funeral of Nora Tapp—The funeral of Nora Tapp, the 14-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Tapp, of Murray, was buried yesterday forenoon after funeral services at the South Cottonwood meetinghouse. The service was largely attended. Classmates of the girl acted as pallbearers.

State Board Diplomas—The state board of education has issued the following diplomas and certificates: State high school diplomas, J. M. Martin, Park City; Preston D. Richards, and Elsie Jane Ward, Salt Lake City. State temporary high school certificates, Mary Gertrude Morton of Montezuma, Ia.

Adjusting Taxes—The county commissioners met yesterday as a board of equalization and a few petitions from the people were heard. In some instances, the abatements were granted. The board will meet nearly every day during the month of June to hear complaints on the assessments.

Death of Margaret Moody—Mrs. Margaret Moody, mother of William H. McIntyre, Samuel McIntyre and Mrs. J. T. Donahue, died at the residence of the first named son, 253 S. 8th avenue, yesterday afternoon. She was 82 years of age, and had resided in Salt Lake for many years. The funeral will be held from the number indicated, Wednesday, commencing at 3 o'clock.

Mother is Grateful—Mrs. Bessie Yutz, of Butte, mother of Willie Yutz, the 14-year-old boy who ran away from home and landed in Salt Lake some weeks ago, and was cared for and sent home by the officers of the juvenile court, has written a letter thanking the officers for their care of her boy. She says she is afraid the boy might want to return, he was treated so well while here.

Old Time Currency—Two curiosities in the shape of money were taken in at the city treasurer's office yesterday in payment for taxes. They were both bills of the Salt Lake currency, one bearing date of 1865, value 25 cents, and signed by Robert Campbell, city auditor, and the other was for \$2 of the issue of 1868, also bearing the signature of Auditor Campbell. Both were quite specimens of the old city paper money, and will doubtless be treasured as interesting relics.

Unsanitary Slaughterhouse—John Peterson, state food and dairy commissioner, has sworn to a complaint in Justice Hardy's court, in Bountiful, in which he charges Xaverius Frank Meoel of South precinct, DeWitt county, with allowing a slaughterhouse to remain in an unsanitary condition. Mr. Peterson has just returned from a trip of inspection of the slaughterhouses of Bingham and Park City, and may have some more complaints to make in the near future.

VIEWS CITY'S NEEDS.

Architect Arnold W. Bunner of New York, who has been brought to Salt Lake by the Auerbach estate to look over the situation before planning a new building for the Auerbach property, has spent the past two days looking over the city's general perspective and will return east in a few days to commence work on plans of the building. The leases now on the property will expire by fall, when they will be vacated, and the new building will be commenced. It is thought by Mr. Bunner that a year or a little less will be required in building, and that the structure will be six stories in height, fire proof, and in keeping with the progress of the architecture of the city. The building lot has a frontage of 140 feet and a depth of 320 feet. The company hopes to have the building ready for the fall trade of 1909.
