President Tobin of Utah League
Calls Attention to
Rules.

LITTLE TROUBLE IS NOTICED

But the Value of "The Ounce of Prevention" Is Appreciated—
East to Nip Evil.

There has been little betting going on at the baseball games in this or the other cities included in the Utah State Amateur league, but President Tobin of the league believes that the ounce of "prevention" is worth a pound of the "cure" for he is sending the following letter to managers of clubs:

TOBIN'S LETTER:

To the Managers of the Utah, Base ball and Soft Ball Leagues, Please call your attention to the following rules which you are expected to enforce:

Rule 76 (Baseball Guide). No manager, captain or player shall address the spectators during the game, except in reply to a request for information about the progress or the state of the game.

Section 10 (constitution and by-laws) of the baseball and softball leagues, no player shall in any way lay any wager upon any game of ball in which they may participate, and if so doing, the manager, captain or player should that the brakes fail there would be no opportunity of throwing in a gear to control the machine by its own means. It is the duty of the managers to demand a level speedway.

The Automobile club road to Saltair would give a 15-mile straightaway, the distance from Ogden to Saltair being about 10 miles. The road going round for a machine, it only is kept free from chuck holes.

Hence has arisen the demand for a level speedway, and President Hewlett has busied himself for the past few days in seeing what arrangements can be made with the road company for a road parallel to its own, on its right of way.

Messrs. Nelson and Langford of the Saltair management are endeavoring to have the above rules and see that they are enforced.

Betting should not be allowed on the grounds and the home team is responsible for the conduct of the crowd. I do not believe that there has been much betting at the games, but if so doing, some spectators persist in creating a lot of noise concerning some little bet that they wish to make.
