THE COUNTY COURT.

Meetings held and the sheriff's salary discussed.

The county court held two sessions yesterday, at 10 a. m. and 2 p. m. At the morning session the following petitions were presented and passed upon.

Three petitions were filed against the change of road in Big Cottonwood, by the B. C. Power company, unless such road was made as good as it had been before. Referred to the road committee.

Jacobus M. Pitts, Andrew P. Erickson and J. S. Dickinson filed petitions for the redemption of property from tax sale. Referred to the road committee.

John C. Weaver, tax collector, submitted an additional report, in which was included his bill for services rendered. Filed.

Hotel liquor licenses were granted to Fritz Miller, James Richards, Jake Newman and C. H. Hagg. Licensed on Monday next.

James Cahoon, who has a claim of \$1,300 against the county, was advised of a writ of certiorari on Monday next.

This finished the business of the morning session and an adjournment was taken until 2 p. m.

The 2 o'clock meeting commenced about 2:15 and was given very hastily by the distribution of the sheriff's salary. Attorney Fenno appeared for Sheriff Harby.

The sheriff had filed a bill of \$21,218 for feeding county prisoners. The court passed upon it and reduced it to \$10,725. He had also filed a bill of \$250 for services as cattle inspector, but the bill was not taken up, as it was not an itemized statement.

Attorney Fenno argued that it was impossible to render an itemized account of such services, as there are so numerous and rendered to so many different individuals. Mr. Fenno said that it cost the sheriff \$450 per month to maintain the office of his office, and that unless he was allowed a certain salary per month for such branch of business which he was expected to attend to, he would fall short of receiving a just remuneration for his services.

Assistant Judge declared that Sheriff Harby was getting more pay than any sheriff in this county, and considered the sheriff for paying his bill of \$10,725 for his services, when the deputy in the execution office was only paid \$75.

A few more discussions regarding the cost of feeding the prisoners, the whole matter was dropped till next Monday.

Then the matter of paying the deputy sheriff for services on the 4th, and so on, was taken up. Mr. Fenno made a motion to pay for such services as he made payable to the sheriff. Mr. Harby refused to draw them out unless he was allowed the present percentage. The county attorney asked the deputies were to get their money, but that they could not get it unless it was drawn out by the sheriff, as the law called for such mode of procedure.

Then it was decided to pay the bills and an appropriation covering the payment of all the bills but that of Deputy Smith's, claiming that he was on a salary and was not entitled to pay for such services.

Further discussion of the sheriff's salary will be had on Monday next.

CRUSHED BY A CAVE IN. Wm. B. Andrews Meets His Fate in the River Mine.

William D. Andrews, a miner employed at the River mine, met with an accident yesterday which cost him his life. He was engaged, with two others, in removing a stump and had just made the first stroke of the pick, when a cave occurred which completely buried the unfortunate Andrews. He was taken out with all possible haste, but died a few minutes later.

A coroner's jury was immediately summoned and the company held responsible in making the man to work in an unsafe place.

Mr. Andrews was about 25 years of age, was married, but had no family. He was greatly respected by all who knew him, being a sober and industrious citizen. His wife was residing at 314 S. Creek when the accident occurred.

The company will either pay loss by being held responsible for the accident, or they will pay for the cost of an insurance policy, which pays all damages for which the company may be held liable.

IN A MADMAN'S GRIP. Fearful Experience of a Farmer's Wife Near Salt Lake.

"He's got another of his spells," said the boy excitedly. He was called, and he fled like a rabbit to the woods. The little boy went to Walling for assistance.

E. C. Walling, Big Gap, a powerful fellow who works for John Backus, Jackson, Idaho, was called upon for his response. When they came up to Perry he ran and was soon lost to view in the darkness.

They then started away, believing their short escape. They had proceeded but a short distance when their eyes were greeted by the wild shrieks of a madman. They rushed back to find Mrs. Nugent struggling in the grasp of the madman. He had stealthily approached her, and was now holding her without a moment's warning.

She struggled for a moment, but was like a cat in his paw. She screamed and the madman came to her aid. The man pointed upon Perry and released Mrs. N. Mrs. N. accompanied to capture Perry, but he fought like a tiger, leading the madman to strike. A few minutes later Perry took another look, saying he was going to Walling. The man volunteered to come to town with him and be considered. In the meantime they had telephoned to Sheriff Moseley.

He and with their clothing easily disappeared, the party came down the street out from the National with the crazy passenger. Arriving in the city they left the car and encountered Sheriff Moseley and a force of half a dozen deputies.
