

FUSION TICKET TO BE RATIFIED

Platform and Candidates Presented at Special Convention in Theater This Afternoon.

REPUBLICANS ARE INCLUDED

It is Expected They Will Enter on General Ticket With the Exception of the Mayor.

The Citizens' and Democratic fusion ticket will be ratified at 3 o'clock this afternoon in the Salt Lake theater, when the platform on which the candidates are to stand will be presented. In the pledges which have already been outlined a business administration is the foundation for the movement. With this, the platform carries the elimination of politics, reformation in the methods of handling the city's advertising, the manner of keeping accounts in the city auditor's and city treasurer's departments, and competent officials in every department.

On account of the interest manifested in the movement, it is expected that the theater will be filled to its capacity. To call for the convention, as printed, states that the meeting is a re-opening of the Democratic convention which was held in Salt Lake City. The Citizens' leaders are invited to attend and all those who are interested in the fusion movement.

DEMOCRATIC TICKET.

In view of the complications which might arise on account of the amendment to the election laws, the name of the fusion ticket will be known officially as the "Democratic Ticket." This is done in order that fusion may be accomplished all along the line without interfering with the election laws. The inscription, however, is the Citizens' ticket, which is accepted by the Democrats.

It is expected that the Republicans will enter into a fusion on the same basis as well as the general ticket, except on the mayor. There are a few Republicans who are advocating and urging this now, and it is believed that the movement will be successful.

RESOLUTION ADOPTED.

The Citizens' committee held a meeting last night at which time the situation was gone over thoroughly. As a result, the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, The Citizens' movement was begun solely for the purpose of giving to our city a clean, dignified, progressive administration and not an attempt to force the fusion turned that has for so long retarded our growth and shamed our city; and,

Whereas, The promoters of said movement from its inception planned and hoped that the entire nation and parties in the nation placing of the most representative men in each party on a common ticket; and,

Whereas, This object seemed to be impossible until the Democratic city committee, perceiving the importance of the continuation of the local strife caused by the very nature of the movement, submitted the proposition of fusing with the Citizens' party to a re-enacted convention, where the question of withdrawing their regular ticket would be considered, and placing a fusion ticket by petition as a substitute.

Whereas, A more careful consideration of all of the problems to be met, and particularly the unfortunate wording of the new election law, inclines them to the belief that this would be a compromise, the very nature of which would be attained in that the new provides any hope of fusing after a fusion ticket has once been filed; and,

Whereas, Fusion on the councilmanic level would thereby be honored and their most cherished hopes defeated; and,

Whereas, A strong public sentiment demands that they do nothing that will frustrate a fusion plan on any part of the ticket; now, therefore, be it resolved:

That the Citizens' committee get the candidates heretofore mentioned upon for the Citizens'-Democratic ticket, because of said technicalities, placed upon the official ballot under the title, "Democratic Ticket," and further, that this method be followed as the most safe and practical method of fusion under the 1909 election laws.

TICKET AGREED UPON.

The ticket agreed upon at the conference committee meeting of the Citizens' and Democrats was as follows:

Mayor—W. H. Wallace, Democrat.

City Attorney—George N. Lawrence, Republican.

Auditor—W. H. Lovsey, Republican.

City Treasurer—A. H. Peabody, Republican.

City Recorder—Harr J. Fitzgerald, Democrat.

As soon as this ticket is ratified at the convention this afternoon it will be filed with the state election board. It will undoubtedly be affected on the councilmanic candidates in all of the wards and tomorrow a vigorous campaign will begin for a business administration.

STATE LAND LAWS.

Secretary Farnsworth is Preparing Pamphlet on the Subject.

W. H. Farnsworth, editor of the state board of land commissioners, is busy preparing for publication a pamphlet bearing on provisions of the government act of 1908, with special reference to Carey Act Bings. The pamphlet will contain a copy of the state land laws as amended by the last legislature, also a copy of the Carey act with the requirements of each fully set forth, so many inquiries have been received on this subject. The author writes regarding Carey act notices that it was deemed necessary to issue such a booklet. In this pamphlet applications for registration of lands under the Carey act are made in improper form, and for this reason some of the applications have been held up by the land board. He writes to the editor of the Deseret News, "I am necessarily for submitting improperly gotten up applications, as the booklet will contain all the requirements of the government act, and I am sure that Mr. Farnsworth expects to have the pamphlet ready for distribution about the first of November."
