The Mining Companies' Dispute Again Before Judge Zane Today.

THIS was the second day of the trial of the mining suit in which the Colorado American de Minas de Lehi, the plaintiff, and the Old Gold Mining and Milling Company is the defendant. The same counsel appeared as yesterday. The complainant, as already stated in the news, sets forth that the plaintiff company and the defendant corporation were tenants in common in the Jordan or Talmage mine, and that the plaintiff company sold to the defendant working interest in the mine, and was paid \$10,000. The defendant was to pay the proportion of the expenses, \$15,725.44, suit was instituted to recover that amount, and \$203.55 paid by the defendant to the plaintiff.

There are quite a number of experts and other witnesses to be examined, and the legal contest promises to be a long and costly affair.
