LIBERALS WON'T TAKE OFFICE

Thies Crown Will Pledge Enough Peers Will be Appointed to Carry Financial Measures,

London, Nov. II.-"It is my opinion that it is impossible that any Liberal government can ever again bear the heavy burden of office, unless it is secured against a repetition of treatment such as other measures had to undergo for the last four years."

This sensational declaration by Lord Loroburn, lord high chancellor, in the debate on the budget in the house of lords today, had an electrical effect upon Liberal members of the house of commons who crowded the galleries.

Lord Loweburn replied, contending that there was nothing in the bill foreign to finance with which the house of commons had the exclusive right to deal.

What was embedded in the bill was not new, either in the Unit-ed States or Germany, and had been approved, not only by the present, but by the inte benae of commons.
