PARK CITY AND TINTIC STOCKS.

All the Trading Done on Mining Exchange During Forenoon Calls Confined to Them.

MAY DAY MOVES DOWN AGAIN.

No Eagle & Blue Bell Offered--Daily and Daily-Judge Active--Closing Quotations and Sales.

All the business transacted on the floor of the Salt Lake Stock & Mining Exchange this forenoon was confined to Park City and Tintic stocks. May Day, Joe Bowes, Carina, Lower Mammoth and Uncle Sam Consolidated. May Day moved down to 74 cents, but managed to recover to 8 cents, at which a board lot changed hands on the open board. Carina weakened a few points. Consolidated Mammoth, offered at 10 cents, was met with a bid of 48½ cents, no stock selling. A bid of 38 cents for Eagle & Blue Bell met with no response, while Yankee Consolidated remained at about where it was yesterday.

The trading sessions were Daily and Daily-Judge, the former going at \$2.65 and the latter at \$2.55. New York Bonanza was not brought out, 62 cents was bid for it and 63½ cents asked. Boston C. ton, stiffened slightly. The closing quotations and sale were as follows:
