**A Fatal Accident—Police and Fire Department Fully Organized.****Special for Deseret Telegraph:**

Ogden, April 10.—A frightful accident occurred in the railroad yards this yesterday forenoon by which Christian F. Crotter of Firth, was crushed into an almost shapeless mass, which caused his death at about 7:30 this morning. He was 20 years old and had married a widow with two daughters and a brother and a sister. The brother and one daughter now in California, and the sister now in Ogden, 34 years of age, and had resided in Ogden about nine years. The funeral will be held over the grave tomorrow, at 2 P.M., at the First Presbyterian Church, on Wednesday next.
