Sam'l Capener, a man of 40 years, was recently shot to death near Fielding, Box Elder County, during the shooting of rabbits. The accident occurred at 1 p.m. yesterday while out on a rabbit hunt. The party were riding in a wagon when some unknown marks a shot was discharged. The load struck Mr. Capener in the right side and passed through his body. He died immediately. His wife and five children were riding in the same wagon.
