A VILLAGE SWALLOWED UP.

The Mining Town Scotch Valley Destroyed by a Cave-In.

The Mining Way of Timbers and Supports in a Coffin Case the Disaster.

LEWIS, Pa., Sept. 5.—The little mining town of Scotch Valley, near this place, was swallowed up tonight in one of the most complete and sudden cave-ins ever known in this region. The scene of the disaster is on the slope of Mount Lehigh, the scene of houses comprising the hamlet being at the mouth of the shaft of the Mount Lehigh colliery. The village, which was situated on the edge of the mountain, was completely swallowed up in the falling mass and nothing was seen of it but the ruins of the houses and the ruins of the colliery.
