THE GREASER SHOOTING.

The Preliminary Examination Before Justice Keiser.

TESTIMONY OF WITNESSES.

The Prosecution Sets Up That Richardson Was the Assassin.

The Arguments.

The case of John Greaser charged with the attempted killing of Jerry Richardson, was resumed in the police court before Justice Keiser today.

At the hearing last evening testimony was introduced by the prosecution tending to show that Richardson was the assassin.

The defendant was represented by Knight and Anderson while county and assistant county attorneys Murphy and Eickhoff appeared for the prosecution.

At 11:45 this forenoon Hergert Randolph was first called. He testified that he had known the defendant for eighteen or twenty years; on the evening of his arrest he complained of a severe pain in the head.

There was a swelling on the left side of the head, presumably caused by a heavy blow. He was almost in a fainting condition a short time after being placed in jail.

He took him out to allow him to get a little fresh air. He gave him a drink in "brown" him up, and offered him something to eat, but he refused to partake of anything.

Cross-examined—The blow might have been caused by his head coming in contact with a table or any other piece of furniture. He knew defendant in Nevada. He said he knew he was a peevish man.

Deaf Sergeant Castle's testimony corroborated that of Sergeant Randolph.

Mr. Weiler, commander of the Gen. H. Maxwell Post, testified that he had recently met the defendant at Washington.

Colonel Knight—What was your opinion at that time as to the moral or non-moral condition of his mind?

Mr. Murphy—I object unless you wish to show that he was temporarily insane.

Colonel Knight—He was sane at the time.

Colonel Knight—What did you see in the stand?
