

A VIEW OF CALIFORNIA.

Editor's Note: It will not be asking too much if I would be pleased if you would allow me the use of a small portion of your valuable space to present a few items in connection with our article published in the October Waspay of the 2nd issue, entitled "The Dredging of Muddy," which is given as an extract from the San Francisco Chronicle.

The article referred to asks the question, "How, then, can we hope to cultivate modesty in the rising generation when it is common to and encouraged by glister and stomach undress?" If the statement be true that there are 45,000 establishments in the state dealing in intoxicating liquor, and they are kept open on Sunday, how can the people be expected to observe the Sabbath? We have no Sabbath here, and the Sabbath is observed only by the few who are most religious, and those few are few indeed, and will not be able to make up for the sins of the many who do not observe it.

It is an opinion among us that the people really want the interval of their Sabbath protected, why do they not go to work right away? The law is on the books, and the executive laws are to be carried with the object to be attained, and these weak officers who will see that these laws are enforced. We have to meet the old-timers that are in our communities in a spirit of wary watch over the people, or will occur over the heads of some of the cities of California, if not all, have a full police officer patrolling those streets that are infested by prostitutes and other vices, and to quicken prompt in calling their deacons and elders part of the church. The principal difficulty that seems to confront these saints is that they may not keep their doors open. But they are allowed to do so, at all times, inasmuch as they are in keeping with their profession, and social patronage. And the writer of this article, having occasion to pass through a street in that portion of the city of San Francisco, saw a number of women, as well as men, window-looking with the females within, while at the same time there were boys of sixteen or eighteen years talking with others of the same class nearby.

The people tell me that they cannot think of any time of the year, as now, as more Mormons or their religion, and at the same time they have the money to prevent such institution as referred to above. Is it any wonder that a servant of God, who has been sent to preach the gospel, has no time to do his duty? The writer has met several who pretended to listen to his testimony, and who promised to investigate, and asked him to come to their home at stated times, and then ran away from him.

It seems almost impossible to find any one who will listen to our belief. In a meeting in San Francisco, a number of intelligent ministers, a Methodist, and a Presbyter, agreed that he ought to continue his meetings until we witness that a righteous person of God there are none here. We noticed, while in San Francisco, that most and strongest on the streets did not induce people to follow him, and that the pulpit was pitched for the purpose of holding "gospel" meetings.

It is a true silver question that is causing such conditions. It is to be hoped that our law-makers will be induced to take action in this matter. Congress is to consider the present condition existing, as many important facts, the history of which will better go to work in real earnest and remedy a few of the evils.

There are five Elders in the California mission at present, and so far as proselyting is concerned, there is little to encourage them. But perhaps the morality of the people has something to do with it.
