THE LATE "LIBERAL" CONFERENCE.

Two alleged members of the "Liberal" party which concluded its session last night was not what it purported to be. That is to say, it was not a conference. The proposition it was ostensibly called to consider and discuss was virtually, we might say practically, disposed of before the meeting was called for. The Tucumcari band had, long since, the "Mormon" people announced their leaving here for Chicago with his party that even if adolled at the National Democratic Convention, the delegation would return with colors flying and continue the old fight. The Tucumcari was disbanded and the alleged conference was called simply to endorse what had been already decided by the gathering in advance.

Anything more than the industry announcement of the determination of future Tucumcari action were denied. It was given as the alleged conference result. Those who expressed any views contrary to the affirmative of the propositions were, as may be easily discerned, their utterances being drowned in yell, shout and other sounds and semi-sounds of denunciation.

The Pacific coast people are urging a political economy argument against the Chinese. Taking this driving process for thirty years means the removal of \$360,000,000 in gold dust from the State. This is the argument in trade and industry now prevailing on the Coast.

If this opposition of ours has a depressing effect on the business of the Pacific side, how much more reason to complete the Atlantic road than the American tourist scene which Europe this year, it is estimated, will spend over \$200,000,000 without any corresponding return. Yet this would never be used as an argument to justify the keeping at home of wealthy but idle legal counsel.

It is reported that the appropriations made by the Congress during the session now about to adjourn will aggregate \$10,000,000. If so, this makes \$20,000,000 more than the appropriations made by the first session of the Hilden daher Congress.

Hiram O'Donnell, the leader of the Horned Devil's, testified before the Congressional committee that he was meeting in wages \$150 a month, and that the new scale proposed by the Carnegie company did not in any way affect his wages. O'Donnell and his colleagues were forced by a little jealousy in the ranks of the Pinkertons. It appears that Pinkerton, especially the man known as "Hill," has had trouble with employees very frequently. He has trouble with one in particular—name Nordin, who did a great deal of work in Peoria. He is the son of a well-known anarchist. Nordin started an agency of his own after leaving Peoria, and the other day, while advertising "Hill's" had his services several times, but nothing of the sort. Nordin's services to the Pinkertons were terminated, and he is now kept by O'Donnell advised. So that the strikes were fully prepared.

The leading and more intelligent "Liberal" predicted the early defeat and dissolution of the party. We include those who favored the affirmative side of the four propositions. They all assumed that early dissolution was inevitable. This being evidently the conviction in the minds of these gentlemen, the reason for the anxiety to have an affirmative endorsement of the four propositions submitted in the alleged conference at once leaps into view. It is estimated that there is not a shadow of possibility of a "Liberal" candidate for representative to Congress being elected, yet it is desired to put one in the field. The purpose of determining to name one for the position is simply and solely to thwart the party organization that would follow the indication to do this. The result would be disastrous to any prospect that might exist for the existing party to capture, in future, any of the offices of Salt Lake County. This is their only chance, however remote it may be, to capture any renegade offices, and as long as there exists a shadow of suspicion by in that line, it will be held against them and construed. Hence the object is not general, saying that the time being hopeless but territorially local, involving a last party effort to obtain official political office.

We have frequently noted the pronounced nature of this general attitude, because the chief plotters behind the leading activities have been the "Mormon" people, excommunicated and excommunicated.
