In Execution Yet, But Some Departures from the Islands.

## THE EX-QUEEN'S TRIAL PENDING.

A Suit of Judge Without Conviction of Treason—Other Persons Found Guilty.

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 15.—The ex-queen Marianne (now Hawaiian) arrived today with news that there have been no executions yet. The ex-queen's trial is pending. William Evans, charged with treason, was the only man deported on the ship.
