ARE MORE MEN NEEDED?

There is already some talk of leaving another unit for volunteers, this time 100,000 men. While it is to be hoped that the war may be over before the necessity for another unit upon the part of the country arises, it cannot be overruled that circumstances now exist which may make this step unavoidable.

When war was first declared, only the liberation of Cuba was contemplated, and this, it was supposed, could be done in a comparatively short time, with the aid of the Cuban insurgents under General Gomez. Since then the country has been called upon to do the Philippines problem. General Sherman is asked to give over 6,000 miles from home to conquer an archipelago defended by a Spanish army. To do this he needs a reinforcement of at least one equal to that needed for Cuba.

TINGED WITH SOCIALISM.

There is much to be said in favor of the principle enunciated in the phrase, "initiative and referendum," that is, the suggestion and determination of legislation by the people themselves. It is a principle which has been provided for in the constitution of many of our states, and it is a principle which has been found to be of great value in the government of a free people.
