LONDON, 23.—In the House of Commons this evening, Professor Fawcett moved that in the opinion of the House any promise of reform made by the Government without guarantees will be fruitless, and that the Powers, in the interest of the peace of Europe, have a right to demand adequate securities for the better government of Turkey.
