Five Butters Explode With Fatal

CHICAGO, Jan. 8.—Five butters
exploded tonight in the Warren Spring
manufacturing building on Canal
street, killing four men and damag-
ing the building to the extent of
\$100,000. The explosion was caused
by a gas leak in one of the butters.
The victims were: John Lee, 40, who
was killed instantly; John Smith, 35,
who was killed a few minutes after
the explosion; and three others who
were seriously injured.
