SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 26.—Blair from the committee on education and labor, reported back the House bill directing the commission of labor to make an investigation as to convict labor.

The resolution offered by Gibson last Saturday calling on the Secretary of the Interior for information as to the progress made by the Surveyor General of Louisiana in satisfying and adjusting the land claims in the State was taken up and passed.

Locals offered a resolution, which was adopted, requesting the President to communicate information concerning the alleged detention of A. K. Cutting, an American citizen, by the Mexican authorities at Paso del Norte, also whether additional United States troops have been recently ordered to Fort Bliss.

The Senate then proceeded to the consideration of the deficiency appropriation bill.

The reading of the bill was interrupted to permit Dawes to report on the bill in relation to the fortification bill. He gave notice that he would call it up as soon as the deficiency bill had been passed.

An item was inserted to pay Edwin B. Smith \$2,000 for test services rendered the government in the Hawaiian case.

The reading of the bill being disposed of, the bill was open to general amendment.

On motion of Hale an item was inserted of \$25,000 for payment to the railroad companies for the use of the transportation over the non-subsidized railroads operated by the Central Pacific Railroad Company for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1886, and the prior years.

On motion of Dawes an item of \$25,000 was inserted for the Chippewa Indians of Minnesota on account of damages to their lands by the government dam.

On motion of Wilson, of Iowa, an item of \$40,000 was inserted for the United States and Brazil Steamship Company for the mails during the last fiscal year.

The bill was then reported back to the Senate and the bill passed.

The Senate then, on motion of Edwards, went into the recess.

Five minutes later the officers of the Senate were sent to the corridors, committee rooms, and other places, the paper of the second floor, all the occupants of which were promptly ejected.

At 6 o'clock the Senate took a recess until 8 o'clock, at which time the consideration of executive business session will be resumed.

The principal part of the time of the Senate in secret session up to the recess at 6 o'clock was consumed by the Senate in the consideration of the bill for the relief of the Hawaiian Islands.
