

# LOGAN AND MURRAY TOOK ONE EACH.

In Saturday's Game the Smelter Men Defeated the Farmers.

## IT WAS DIFFERENT YESTERDAY

Murrayites Did Not Have a Look in With the Loganiates—They Were Shut Out.

The two games played between teams representing Logan and Murray, Saturday and Sunday resulted in an even break. Murray won Saturday's game, 10 to 8, but in yesterday's struggle, the Farmers from up north got even; yes, more than even, for they shut out the Smelter City team and made four runs.

For semi-professional ball, both games were about the limit, and at times approached the National league golf. In Saturday's game it looked like Logan would have a walkaway, for three or four innings the Loganiates started off like champions and for three innings refused to permit a Murrayite to get as far as second base, but the fourth, however, things began to look favorable for Murray. Eddie Haan was responsible for a couple of runs. The first chance he had at the horsepole he booted it far and wide, and the next chance resulted in a drive to the right field fence. The eagerness to catch a runner he threw the ball into the crowd, and two runs came in. In the fifth more trouble was started with the third gear being taken off. As a result of a error, "Dad" Stewart popped out the first hit, and Sure followed with a two-base. The Murrayites then began to find daylight, and in the next half hour they upped for five hits and as many runs.
