With those who've realized the birth.

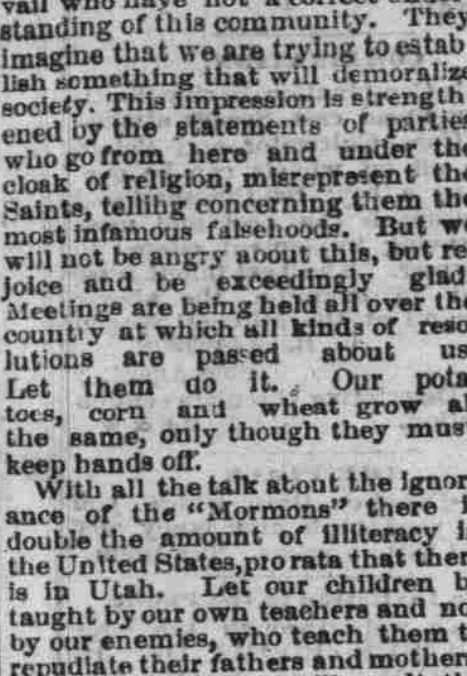
