If only half the spawn came to life, and half the young fish lived, a boat could not move in the sea. There is we believe, a degree of superstition lurking in every mind; and we doubt if any one can thoroughly ex-amine all his secret notions and impulses without detecting it, hidden, perhaps, from himself. It seems, in fact, to be part of our nature, like in-stinct in animals, acting independently of our reason. It is often found existing
