LOCAL BRIEFS.

The State land board concluded its session this afternoon. Only routine matters were dealt with.

As this is the third excursion that that ward has taken this year, no formal program of exercises was prepared, but the day was delightfully spent in social amusements and everything was entirely informal. The evening was employed in the delightful pastime, dancing.
