NEW JERSEY.

TRENTON, Nov. 7.—On July 1st last, the Legislature will probably adjourn. Republicans, 62; Democrats, 28. The Republicans have organized in all their districts except one.

KANSAS.

TOKYO, Nov. 7.—From the Chautaukans of Lawrence, who claim the election of the Republicans here at the next congressional election. He says he has no exact figures, but that the Republicans and Farmers are the largest group in the state, and that they have about 40,000 votes. Mr. C. C. Green, of Wichita, Kansas, has 15,000, and the Republicans have received about 10,000 votes.

We have done every one of the eight congressional districts with a good enough for the Republicans in the new year, and it is difficult to say what the result will be."

With the exception of one from Congressman McGehee, who was defeated, the Republicans have gained in the House, and in the Senate, 12,000, while the Republicans lost 12,000. The Republicans have elected 7 members of the legislature, out of 42. The suffrage amendment is carried in Shawnee County and probably in the state.

The Republicans will have more and probably many chances in the next Congress. The Ohio delegation is now 15, while the Republicans have 20.
