

OBITUARY NOTES.

WILLIAM MCKEEVEY.

Died November 29, 1895, at Salt Lake City, Millard county, Utah, at old age, William McKeevey, aged 82 years. Brother McKeevey was born at St. Louis, Mo., in 1813. He died in 1853, was received into the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in 1857, very shortly after he was ordained a Priest. He was appointed to the office of Bishop, president of the Woodhouse branch almost immediately until he emigrated to Utah in 1861. Located in Payson, he resided there until about 1870, when he moved to Pleasant Grove, Millard county, Mountain Valley.

For many years Brother McKeevey was prominent as a teacher; that was next to a word teacher, the first school teacher in Millard county, he was a man of great energy and zeal. As the organization of the Little Creek Stake, where he was elected superintendent, and is the present president of the same. For many years he was postmaster, and in his old age he still教 each time in Provo. He was known as being unexcelled in promptness and honesty in his small business.

He died in full faith in the Gospel, having retained a high place after serving as president of the Endowment for many years.

Millennial Star dies.

Lester L. Lakin, who died on November 29, at his home in Spring City, Sanpete county, and whose obituary has already received brief mention, was born January 20, 1861, at Orem, Utah, now deceased. His parents were George and Anna L. Lakin, of Copenhagen, by C. Christensen, and continued on the following day by J. E. Forgrave. On the 28th of December, 1881, he was received into the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, his instruction, however, in the Fredericks conference under the direction of his brother, G. J., at the time of his death, was well advanced.

He was ordained a deacon in the Fredericks conference, and appointed to labor in Richfield and vicinity. In the spring or summer of 1882 he was called to receive the Aaronic priesthood, and was filled with power until 1887, when he was released to Provo, Utah, where he served in the office of First Elder. During the time of his service here he was sent from President Brigham Young for the people to move south, and during the summer he moved to Fort Douglas, Sanpete county, where he remained until his call to the office of First Elder in Spring City, where he located permanently. On May 21, 1887, he left home on a mission to his native country, where he was appointed to the office of First Elder, a position which he filled for four years, when he was appointed by President Jesus N. Smith as traveling Elder to the State of Colorado, during the remainder of his term. He was released on the 14th of July, 1890, and was received into his mortal home with a company of about 200, and 200 friends, at Salt Lake City, April 10, 1891. He remained here in the "Bishopric of Spring City" for thirteen years. He was a popular and useful in secular as in ecclesiastical work, and died in the peace of his soul, and served two terms as mayor of Spring City. His last will in the service of the people was when he was invited to speak at the annual General Conference. Two wives and two daughters preceded him to the other side, and a wife, two children, and a host of friends followed him home. It can truly be said of him, that he lived and died a faithful, consistent Latter-day saint. May he rest in peace until the morning of the first resurrection.—C. M. McKEEVEY.
