### GRAY STORIES IN ENGLAND.

WHAT WITH A LONDON GOVERNMENT CONTRACTOR—MADE OVER GOODS.

I spent an evening with Mr. William Pope, one of the largest dealers in my stores in England, and in the course of the interview he told me a number of curious facts in connection with the business.

"Why, bless me," said the wealthy dealer, "it has been times when I could have clothed and equipped a full sized army on a day's notice. I have had an old chapel full of rifles, a warehouse full of swords, a hundred thousand helmets and as many coats,

"It was after the Phoenix Park murder. The great market for the rifles was broken up now, and the government became alarmed and the law was issued to break up all the rifle clubs. I suppose they will go on breaking them up until doomsday. But we have no more rifles to sell."

"Of course they were, but that was before the war. The natives like the old paint with the stocks painted red. Why not get some of those old stocks from Norfolk, making flint locks to them and send them out in barrels and exchange them for the new ones? These flint guns and old swords are sent out in barrels and exchanged for the new ones. I have received as many as 20,000 of these. Now the British government employs men at 25a week to make rifles, muskets and firearms of all kinds."

"What becomes of the uniforms?"


