Editor Deseret News:

The people of this place were called upon yesterday to witness a rather singular event: two corpses in the meeting-house at the same time—Bros. Orange Warner and Jos. Judson having departed this life, both firm in the principles of the Gospel and full of days, each of them having passed three scores and ten. Remarks suitable for the occasion were made by Elder Nephi Pratt, President J. V. Robison, Elder Allen Russell and President I. N. Hinckley.

The health and spirit of the people here are generally good. The fruit prospects are good and would be excellent were it not for the "codling moths." The season has been very favorable for the farmers, and bright hopes are seen pictured on their countenances. Many of the male members of our community have left for work on the railroads, and it is expected that ere long "men will be precious as gold."

The school year has closed, and our school election passed off without opposition. Bro. H. J. McCullough was re-elected trustee, and a tax of one-fourth of 1 per cent. was voted for.

Besides our regular district school, divided into three grades, attended last winter by about 240 pupils, taught by four teachers, we have also a Presbyterian school, attended mostly by the children of the non-"Mormon" element; the teacher of said school appears to be a young lady of culture and education; her religious views are not endorsed by the "Liberals" as a general thing, but anything rather than "Mormonism," hence her bible teachings about the Savior, the atonement, etc., are tolerated, although by some of the "Liberals" considered as folly.

The course of conduct as taught by the authorities and adopted by the Saints here, is to treat all ladies and gentlemen as such, regardless of their religion or no religion, and not ridicule anyone because he or she does not believe as we do.
