

PUNISH THE LAND SWINDLERS,
SAYS PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 18.—Men who have committed frauds against the land laws of the government and have endeavored to cheat the United States of its public domain will be prosecuted to the limit of the law. It has been made easy to obtain land in the United States. Settlers who want land have had no difficulty in making their entries and obtaining title. The law has not been hard to comply with. No burden was put upon the settler more than that which falls to the lot of the average pioneer. The persons who have been engaged in the frauds are those who desire to obtain valuable lands without conforming to the law. They are being found out, and they are being prosecuted. There will be no let-up in these prosecutions as long as Theodore Roosevelt is president. He is determined that the men who have been cheating the government must suffer.

HITCHCOCK WILL STAY.

One result of unearthing the land frauds is that Secy. Hitchcock will remain in the cabinet. It was generally believed that Hitchcock would close his public career on March 4, but Roosevelt will insist that he remain and continue his work against the land thieves. For years western members of Congress have expressed their displeasure with the administration of the interior department. Criticisms of the secretary have appeared in the papers, and western men have expressed their disapproval to the president. It has never developed just what the objections to Hitchcock are except that the western men were always having trouble with him. Now, however, with all the various fraud cases pending, any one who talks about the removal of Hitchcock will be an object of suspicion. Some one might suggest that he wanted to get lands patented to which there was a questionable title or that he desired to save some friends who had been in crooked land business.

ARIZONA IS HERE.

You can run against a man from Arizona almost anywhere about the Capitol these days. They are here for the purpose of defeating the joint statehood bill. These Arizona people do not relish the idea of being tied up to New Mexico. Of course they will get it, but New Mexico will get every thing else save one member of Congress. The men from Arizona declare that their people would prefer to remain out of the Union rather than come in doubled up with New Mexico. Among the prominent Arizona men are M. F. Murphy, miner and railroad man; N. C. Murphy, former delegate and former governor; and Mark Smith, ex-delegate and delegate elect. They have been making a close canvass of the senate, and they believe that things are so well fixed that the bill will never go through.

TERRITORIAL DIVISION.

Two years ago when the statehood bill under Quay's management was pending in the senate the three territorial delegates, Flynn of Oklahoma, Rodey of New Mexico and Smith of Arizona, were all working together. Now there is a different division. McGuire of Oklahoma and Rodey are on the Republican side, working with Beveridge and Nelson of Arizona. Smith and Mark Smith are on the Democratic side, working with Dubois, Bailey and Bate, who have made their arguments with a view of holding up the bill until the session dies. The activity of these territorial representatives is one of the interesting features of the debate.

BACK TO THE ELEVENTH CAVALRY.

If Senator Scott's bill abolishing five regiments of cavalry should pass that noted regiment of fiction, the Eleventh cavalry, could again be the pet of novel writers. For years there were but ten regiments of cavalry, so the novelist, with a license to which he was entitled, always wrote about a troop of the Eleventh cavalry. In that way he could either protect real officers and men or he could create an entirely new scene in which the gallant Eleventh could become heroes. Now that there is a real sure enough Eleventh cavalry the novelist has had to write about the Sixteenth or Seventeenth.

AN UNPOPULAR SUGGESTION.

The proposition made by James R. Garfield, chief of the bureau of corporations, to require a license from all corporations doing interstate commerce business is meeting with all kinds of opposition. Some people assert that the scheme is unconstitutional, but the main objection to it is that it is impracticable. The impression is that Mr. Garfield will have to try again. It is not believed that even an attempt will be made to carry out his ideas with legislation.

BATE AND FATHER TIME.

"When Dakota came here for statehood some six or eight years ago," said Senator Bate while discussing the statehood bill, "no one on this side objected to the division of the territory as requested because he thought it was too large." Time no doubt slips away quickly with the venerable Tennessee senator, for it was but 18 years ago this winter that the bill was passed admitting the Dakota, Montana and Washington as states of the Union.
