

TOOLE'S SUMMER SCHOOL.

As Outline of the Work—Teachers' Extension to Graduates.

TOOLE, July 18.—As previously announced in the NEWS, the Toole county official institute (for summer school) will meet in Toole city a few days commencing Monday, July 23, 1894, and continuing for two weeks, until August 6. The instructors named are Prof. M. M. Howard, of the University of Utah, and Miss Emma M. Hyde, teacher of University normal training school.

In addition to the more regular instruction, professors have been secured to deliver lectures in Toole city on other topics of the county.

Prof. J. T. Kingsbury will deliver three lectures.

Prof. Howard will deliver two public lectures upon the following subjects respectively: "Relation of the county to the community of the state," and "Right living."

Prof. C. A. Whiting will deliver a lecture upon "Our day's education," as well as a lecture on "Education." "Elementary History in the Toole county."

Prof. Marshall will deliver an illustrated lecture.

Mr. Reynolds and others will also lecture.

An attractive feature is the great teachers' extension to Toole city on Saturday, August 4. This has been arranged as an outing for the teachers and principals as a rest after their first week's work. It is expected that a large number of the teachers of the Territory will assemble there.

The participation of the principals and teachers is a great public feature during the summer school.
