The Arbitration Treaty Not a Great Diplomatic Victory.

IT DENIES THE MONROE DOCTRINE.

And Compels Us to Submit to a European Monitor our Right to Interfere It.

New York, Jan. 14.—The World this morning says: General Benjamin F. Tracy, former secretary of the navy, when asked his views on the arbitration treaty last night said: "When the signing of the treaty was announced, I thought it one of the greatest triumphs that diplomacy had ever achieved. But since reading with more care what party is to be the test of the treaty I am in doubt, whether we do not by this treaty agree to submit to the arbitration of a European monitor the whole question of the Monroe doctrine and our right to interfere. By article I it is provided that the contracting parties agree to submit to arbitration in accordance with the provisions of this treaty any difference of difference between them, which they may fail to adjust by diplomatic means."

Secretary Olney is reported as declaring that by this treaty England has recognized and affirmed the Monroe doctrine. "I am in doubt," said Olney, "whether this language in the treaty which justifies any such inference. On the contrary, it seems clear that it is a treaty which ratifies the United States' right to submit to arbitration the right to enforce the Monroe doctrine as against England."
