NEW YORK.

Heavy Defalcations in Wall Street.

NEW YORK 13 .- Rumors have been in circulation in Wall Street, since Saturday, of the circulation of certain forged securities, hypothecated with prominent brokers. It appears that bonds of a thousand each have been altered to ten thousand, and with other certificates of registered government stocks, supposed to be stolen, have been used for collateral security to the amount of half a million dollars. The firm said to be implicated is W. E. Gray & Co. The alterations in the bounty loan and stock registered government bonds, as far as already discovered, exceed a quarter of a million. Some of the al-terations are exceedingly well excepted terations are exceedingly well executed, others are poorly done. On Friday the Bank of the Commonwealth discovered that they had three of these altered certificates; they immediately sent for Gray, who redeemed the certificates. Subsequently the officers of the Bank deemed it their duty to report the facts to the Manhattan Company. The of-ficers of that company had an interview with Gray, who protested his in-nocence and stated that he had purchased the bonds from a man named Pratt. No steps were taken to arrest Gray, and on Saturday he made his appearance on the street and borrowed considerable amounts on more of the altered certificates. including seventy thousand from a mercantile bank. The principal losers. as far as certified, are the Mechanics' Bank \$70,000; Howe & Mace \$40,000; Vermillee & Co. \$70,000; Ewell & Co. \$25,000; E. P. Scott \$40,000. The money obtained by Gray & Co., on these secur-ities it is supposed is mainly invested in stock of the Quartz Hill Mining Co. None of the firm have been seen since Saturday. The Stock Exchange has offered a reward of \$50,000 for their apprehension. FOREIGN NEWS.
