WASHINGTON, 24.—Wilson introduced

Information has been received that

the steamer which sunk the emigrant

ship Northfleet off Dungeness light-

house, on Wednesday night, was a

Spanish vessel bound for Cadiz. She

is reported to have put into the harbor

of Havre with her bow damaged and

a large quantity of wrecked stuff from the

Northfleet has come ashore on the

Kentish coast. No bodies have yet

been recovered. A committee, headed

by the Lord Mayor of the city, is be-

ing formed to receive subscriptions for

the rescued passengers, who are desti-

tute.

MADRID, 24.—A thousand men will

sail from Cadiz to-day, to reinforce the

troops in Cuba.

BELLIN, 24.—In the House of de-

puties to-day, a question was asked touch-

ing emigration and the measures which

the government had taken to prevent it.

The minister of the interior replied

that it was impossible to restrict emi-

gration after granting the right to

change domicile. What was wanted was

enlightened and judicious legislation to

elevate and improve the condition of

the people at home. This is what the

government is aiming at, and by such

means it hopes to check the tide of em-

igration.
