## LOCAL AND OTHER MATTERS.

**THEATRE**—This evening the sensational drama, "Tide and Time, the farce, "Did You Ever Send Your Wife to Oglethorpe?" and the "Spectacle of the Illuminated Fountain." We understand that Mr. R. McWade will not be able to arrive here to play the title role in "Rip Van Winkle" before Tuesday evening.

**ARRESTED**—Elder George Q. Cannon was arrested by U. S. Marshal Patrick this afternoon upon a charge similar to that of President Young and Wells. He was immediately released by bail, Elders John Taylor and W. Woodman going surety for his appearance. Bonds \$5,000.

**WON'T DO HERE**—The Chicago Tribune imagines a number of fanatical things concerning what it supposes the people here would do in certain contingencies, and then philosophically proceeds to call them fools for the same. If this kind of logic does for Chicago, it won't do here.

**FRONTIER'S NEW SECTIONAL TOPOGRAPHICAL AND MINERAL MAP OF UTAH**—What the people of this Territory have long been in need of is a good, reliable map of the country in which they live. Such a map Col. Frothingham of the United States Survey, in Utah, has just published, after months of tedious labor in its compilation, and has a heavy expense in having the same engraved. It is 40 by 50 inches in length, drawn on a scale of eight miles to an inch, and is mounted on cloth, showing the general topography and geography of the country, including all the government surveys up to June of this year, by township, sections and fractional sections. Also all the new changes in the boundaries of several counties, description and location of mineral found in Utah, the organized mining districts throughout the Territory, together with the cities, towns, post offices, railroads completed and proposed and other internal improvements. On the lower margin of the map are the names of the principal cities of Utah, a very complete reference is also given, which will be of great assistance to those studying the map, and which also gives the last United States census, by counties, also a table of the cities exceeding over 500 in population. It is the first map of Utah that has ever been offered to the public.

**How is it?**—The Chicago Tribune of Oct. 3rd says: "There is no longer any doubt that the government authorities in Utah are at work in earnest, and fully backed up at Washington, in the effort to purge the Salt Lake Valley of polygamy."

We should like our faith upon this point of backing to be "scientific faith"—"seeing is believing." But the Tribune can have its say. We wish to believe of the government the very best we possibly can. However, it is evident that it has the look sometimes to be exceedingly unfortunate in its choice of missions, for a member set some of them out as being outside of the state of Utah. The Tribune further says: "It is known here," a Washington telegram states, "that the grand jury has indicted Young as an accessory to the murder."

**How's that?** How do grand jury findings get to Washington as soon as found? Do the judiciary telegraph what indictments are coming up to the surface?

**DOUGLAS**, that "veracious" man, kindly informs the Chicagoans, through the Tribune of that city, that "the Mormon newspapers have been in a perfect glow of rage for a month," that "there are fears of serious trouble," that "a crisis is at hand," and that "something must give or break." Just as if anybody believed a word he said.

**QUERY**—When a Judge on the bench descends to Billingsgate, and terms those who differ from him in opinion knaves and fools, must such conduct be considered undignified and presumptuous, or is it to be considered the usual style of his class?

**A DEATH-BLOW AT MORMONISM**—The most of the papers term the present crusade "Mormonism." In its time, has received many "death-blow," but it still lives, and is more vigorous now than ever.

**A PART OF THEIR RELIGION**—The Denver Tribune has the following: "The Mormon President has been at last arrested for that which the States of the country and the United States pronounce a crime, but which is sanctioned by the Mormon religion."

If we recollect aright, we have heard of U. S. Judges declaring that the "crime" in question was not a part of any religion. Whether a judge or an editor is the better authority on what is or is not a part of religion, may be a subject of controversy. We know very well what we consider a part of our religion, or sanctioned by it, much better than either the editor or the judge.

**IT WON'T PAY**—The papers throughout the country are greatly indebted to the "Mormonism," very greatly indebted. Only to think of the thousands of worthless little bits of sensation of which "Mormonism" is the innocent cause, and which are so greedily snapped up by the eager caterers for the sensation seeking of the sensational portion of the public, which portion, by the by, is much larger than is generally supposed. Look at the Koryk class of sensations, and the crowd of correspondents of divers "veracious" causes, or something pertaining or supposed to be pertaining to it, is made the text. Look at these things, and then ask the question—Will it pay for "Mormonism" to be abolished? Can the papers stand it? No, that would be too much of a good thing. It would never do to lose a fertile, sojourner, respectable topic. The papers would allow that they only want "Mormonism" to be abolished, and demoralization, O not that's not the idea with the papers. When they find the crucifiers inclined to push things too far, the papers turn round and crucify the crucifiers, as they richly deserve.
