William Jennings Bryan Sends on \$400 for Prizes for Best Essay.

WILL BE AWARDED ANNUALLY.

Board of Regents Consider Bids for Improvements, Some of Which Are Too High.

At a meeting of the board of regents of the University of Utah late yesterday afternoon, a bequest of \$400 was received from the administrator of the estate of Philip Sherman Bennett, for investment, the interest to make an annual prize for the best essay produced at the University of Utah on the principles of free government.

This prize will make the first regular award to be given annually for undergraduate effort, and will probably be much sought after, as the list of its winners grows in length. The check comes from William Jennings Bryan, and has been received by Secretary-Treasurer D. R. Allen. As the interest from the \$400 at 4 per cent is only \$16 a year, Grant C. G. Plummer has offered to give \$2 a year to increase the sum to \$28.
