SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 14.—The Senate was

prorogued over Sunday.

Among the petitions and memorials

presented, were resolutions from the

recent convention of the United States

Cincinnati, opposing any change in the

patent laws that may tend to injure

property in patent.

Also a petition from the tobacco

dealers, remonstrating against the

adaptation of the tobacco tax, requesting

and praying the tax be allowed to re-

main as it is, also a memorial from the

Board of Trade of Albuquerque, New

Mexico, complaining of certain

acts of the Territorial Legislature, and

praying their annulment.
