The advancement and augmentation by the great number of people who have become members of the Church; for this would be a spiritual guide to a work that is carried on both among mortality and in the spirit world, although the point of membership long strides have been made by the Church. But its influence and its testimony have a much broader scope than mere membership. They have proceeded as spiritual forces in all directions, and in the two-thirds of a century since the Church was organized, an effect of the doctrine principally has been to revolutionize the religiousness of professing Christians in every land. The man who knew professed Christianity as it was at the opening of the present century would scarcely recognize the religion today, whom they have broadened, moved, and strengthened, contrasted with the teaching of pure doctrine by Mormonism. The Lord has been there operating for the increase of light and intelligence, so that all who have been brought to a knowledge of the truth.

During the period since the Church was organized, in later days, doctrine revealed by the Lord has been adhered to persistently, as the perfect law of liberty in the Gospel. The idea of the world have been taught never to it in that progress, but it remains the perfect, transparently beautiful gospel plan, unchanged and unchangeable because it embraces all that is good and pure and true, all that is progressive and existing. The Lord Jesus came in the medium of time, having authority from His Father to accomplish a certain purpose, which He did. He also gave authority to His organized Church in those days to attain a certain result, which was done, and in preparation for His second advent and the hour of judgment. He has given authority to His organized Church to latter days to fulfill a glorious mission, in which it is sure in triumph. He organized His Church to remain on the earth to the full end of its purpose; it has been preserved; the work of the Lord has never been withdrawn and His hand is not turned backward; and the Church of His institution is organized, as on the sixth of April, 1847, the day which marks the state-wide semi-annual conference in this city, this month.

This is no small among the Latter-day Saints that in this conference, as in others, the inauguration of the Almighty will be with His servants. That is the aim of their faith and purpose for which they are placed in authority, and the supplications of Israel will be heard and answered, the spirit of prophecy which is foretelling of Jesus will rest upon the Church authorities, on whom He has anointed His priesthood, and whatever the trials, the hardships, the persecutions, the prosperity of the saints, of all things they are assured of their confirmation, etc., that they will be evidence of great rejoicing, because of the Spirit of the Lord that is present, and happiness of those who believe and serve the Lord.
