The Arrangements Made on Behalf of Venezuela.

THE COURT TO SIT AT STOCKHOLM,

and the King of Sweden to Be His First Member of the Court in action.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 10.—The King of Sweden and Norway, Oscar II, has been chosen by treaty between the United States and Great Britain as the official arbitrator of the Venezuela boundary question. The other arbitrators, four in number, are to be designated by the two chief justices of England and two by the other justices of the United States. This is the final and most important feature of the treaty for the conclusion of which the long-sought negotiations were continuing. The treaty was concluded in Washington last night at the British embassy, Mr. Julian Pauncefote representing the British ministry and Secretary Olney the United States. As a king seldom leaves his country except on state occasions, it is expected that he will be present at the trial, which is expected to begin on Dec. 11 and will conclude at Stockholm for arbitration, and the court is to sit at Stockholm, the capital of Sweden.

The Arbitrators were chosen at 2 P.M.

THE COMING ELECTION.

NOT MUCH Legislation of any Importance Expected.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 10.—Senator Carter of Montana said today he saw no prospect of any important legislation being enacted during the session. He did not believe the Blaine bill would pass, and thought the session would be devoted to the appropriation bills and some minor legislation.

Another bill has been introduced among the names of the California State brick company, which propose to expand \$50,000 in the purchase of a site and the erection of buildings thereon. The bill is to be introduced in the Senate, and it is expected that King will introduce it at the next session. It will consist of a resolution that the bill be referred to a committee of three.

As to local legislation in the west, Senator Carter said he did not believe the Democrats would be able to make much headway. In his opinion, those who were claiming and believed the hard times would be cured by allowing all Republicans to return might be induced to do so if they would meet the tariff fight in the next campaign.

LEAVENWELL, Cal., Nov. 10.—The regular meeting of the city council here was adjourned yesterday in consideration of reports which indicated the early inauguration of another reign of terror. Miners on their way home were said to have been compelled to submit to a further confinement of the mines by wayward and usually benevolent agents of law, and now there are credible reports of a plot to renew the assault which they began on the Comstock and Belmont mines in September last. The council decided to immediately summon the miners to a meeting to consider the passage of a charter ordinance which would clear the streets of gang of young hoodlums who have been very demonstrative toward the incorporated miners.
