

On Monday night, her deck was swept by terrific waves, which caused the vessel to pitch and roll, and the shaking of the main deck and the fore and aft beams. An enormous wave, breaking on her quarter, flooded the double compartment between the hold and the deck. This deck is divided by a partition, the forward being a collision compartment, and the aft a storeroom. In the collision compartment was stored a quantity of Japan drier, the loss of which is heavy. Pump was rigged to relieve the vessel of water and a light hoisted, when the water was exhausted.

Frank Gavin, a seaman, was injured, and James Monahan, blacksmith, was fatally injured by breaking the light of water. The others injured are Henry Hoge, a seaman, Alex. S. Jones, a stowaway, John K. H. a seaman, Joseph Morrison, seaman.
